Recommendations of Special Advisory Committee

Option A:

The MVCA seeks a suitable, existing organization to assume ownership and future management of the R. Tait McKenzie and Dr. James Naismith collections.

And, that the collections **continue** to be housed on site at the Mill of Kintail Conservation Area.

Transitional funding would be provided by the MVCA.



Recommendations of Special Advisory Committee

Option B:

The MVCA maintains ownership of the R. Tait McKenzie and Dr. James Naismith collections and seeks future funding via:

- Memoranda of Understanding with local municipalities and,
- Engagement of the Mississippi Valley
 Conservation Foundation to raise funds to maintain the museum and the collections at the Mill of Kintail.



Recommendations of Special Advisory Committee

Option C:

The MVCA requests an exemption from the new regulations from the Ontario government, on the grounds that the collections are of national significance, in order to provide transitional funding (up to 5 years) while the Museum at the Mill of Kintail is established as a stand-alone, self-financing entity.

Ownership and future management of the R. Tait McKenzie and Dr. James Naismith collections would be assumed by the Museum, once established.
