Mississippi Valley Conservation Authority hereby gives notice that a

A new public safety boom and two anchors will be installed. One of the anchors will be onshore and other one will be in-water in close proximity to the Carleton Place Town Hall Building. The installation will be completed using CME diamond drill managed by a qualified contractor with tailing collection/filtering system. The installation of the anchor will be during the low water level season.
